



ACTS FEES

Application Fee

A one-time non-refundable application fee of \$100 per student (maximum of \$250 per family) is due with the submission of an ACTS application. *For current families, the fee is \$50 for a new student.* An assessment of incoming student(s) will be scheduled after receiving a completed application and fee. The application fee is NOT applied toward tuition.

Security Deposit

For new families, once the admission process is complete and you accept the ACTS enrollment offer, you will submit the following to the ACTS Registrar

- a signed Enrollment Agreement
- a signed Promissory Note for the balance of the total tuition indicating the FACTS payment option selected
- a security deposit of 10% of the total tuition *per student* enrolled at ACTS (submitted through FACTS)

Returning families will receive an *electronic* re-enrollment notification in early December which is due by January 1 to secure your place. To aid the ACTS Board in planning for the coming year, families are asked to indicate their intent to return for the next academic year. When submitting the re-enrollment packet, families will submit the following:

- a signed Enrollment Agreement
- a signed Promissory Note for the balance of the total tuition indicating the FACTS payment option selected
- a security deposit of 10% of the total tuition per student enrolled at ACTS to secure your student's spot at ACTS for the coming year (submitted through FACTS)

All Families: Please note that upon submission of the signed Promissory Note, Enrollment Agreement and security deposit, you are agreeing to pay the balance of the tuition even if you should make a different decision about your participation in ACTS over the summer or during the school year. We thank you in advance for your timely payments as they allow us to pay our tutors and to cover operating expenses.

Payment Options:

FACTS Tuition Management Company has contracted with ACTS to securely collect tuition payments. On their site, you will have the option to select one of three payment plans that best fit your family's budget.
