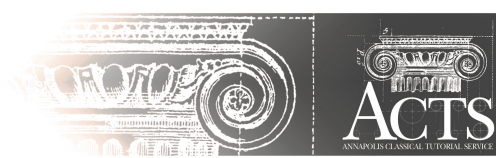


# Scope and Sequence of ACTS Curriculum



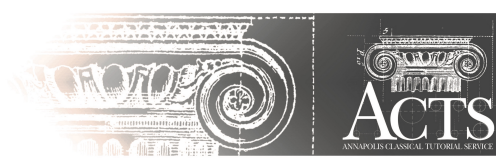
## Kindergarten and Grammar 1

<b>Kindergarten</b>	The focus is on learning the alphabet and counting numbers, proper formation of letters and numbers, general science concepts to develop observation skills, basic geography, and learning classroom etiquette.
<b>Grammar 1</b>	The focus is to reinforce skills and concepts learned in Kindergarten while also introducing knowledge of grammar using Shurley English Level 1. Further exploration of science and history topics continue to hone observation skills.
